## **STEP UP**

The Step Up program is aimed towards yr 7-12 and can either be a full day incursion, 3 different impact sessions done over a few days, or just a 1 off single session. The Step Up program covers the topics of:

Growth Mindset - The Power of YET; Neuroplasticity; The power of the brain; Exploring growth and fixed mindsets; Discovering how we can challenge fixed mindsets

Grit - Just do W.I.T.; Goal setting; Learning from famous failures; Learning to F.O.C.U.S

Wellbeing - Mates that count; Active Constructive Responding (ACR); Rising by lifting others; Affirming others through shout-outs

## **DETAILS AND PRICING**

The investment for this engaging and transformative incursion and included follow-up material is \$18+GST/student (minimum investment of \$1,800+GST/day), plus travel expenses (if applicable). The incursion is run by UPP at your school with a whole cohort of students. The best venue is your school hall (or similar), as we use a learning, action, reflection process throughout the day. For the greatest impact, we recommend that classroom teachers are present and involved for the whole day, as this has many benefits to the students and school moving forward.
